A NOTE FROM OUR DIRECTOR

When I first heard of a group of nearly 900 students studying the Quran in Togo, I was a student myself in South Africa. However, unlike myself, these students were learning, reciting, and memorizing the Quran while crammed into a small, dilapidated structure with little food or a place to sleep. It's been five years since I first heard of these students.

Today, Brighter Futures has not only been able to construct a school for those tenacious Togolese learners but build dormitories and a secular school as well. Moreover, in the past three years, we've expanded well beyond Togo to five countries, creating three maktab programs, nine wells, two schools, and even a hospital wing. We've also been able to donate over 200,000 USD in Zakat and Sadaqah, sponsor over 400,000 meals for students and support the development of an orphanage.

And we're just getting started. We thank Allah SWT for all we've accomplished thus far and ask Him to reward all of our donors for their unending generosity as we continue to support marginalized Muslim communities across the globe.

From purchasing land to build schools to feeding students through our Student Sponsorship Program, Brighter Futures works with local leaders to make a sizeable impact for Muslim communities by delivering resources specific to that community's needs.

PROJECT Snapshots

To date, Brighter Futures Foundation has projects in 5 countries across the globe. We understand that not every community we serve will require the same resources or type of support.

In the following section, we'll explore the how our team has been supporting local leaders as they address specific challenges unique to their communities. Since 2018, our mission in Togo has been to support a community with over 900 students struggling to study the Quran and pursue a secular education through the construction of an educational facility and a masjid on the school grounds.

Since then, we have constructed 7 educational buildings that will be operational in a few months. Thanks to your donations, this school now serves over 1,100 students! We're currently in the process of constructing a masjid.

THE SIERRA LEONE HOSPITAL

WE'VE BROKEN GROUND ON THE FIRST PRIVATE, CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL IN THE COUNTRY TO SERVE 600+ A MONTH



Sierra Leone is a country in West Africa that is home to about 7 million. Over 75% of its population is Muslim. As a whole, the country's health system is woefully inadequate. There are currently no affordable dialysis, MRI, or CT scanning facilities in the entire country.

To support the local community in Calabatown, Sierra Leone, Brighter Futures Foundation has partnered with the Ihsan Foundation to begin building the country's first private children's hospital. The hospital will also be the country's first Muslimoperated hospital and serve a population of over 10,000 lowincome urban and rural dwellers.

SIERRA LEONE

To support the community in Bo, Sierra Leone, Brighter Futures Foundation is supporting two such maktabs, or religious education programs, focused on Quran and Islamic Studies.

These maktabs serve over 130 students, mostly children ages 7-13. Overseeing these maktabs includes covering the salaries for its teachers, providing rental assistance, covering the cost of books, desks, utilities, as well as other operational costs.

2021-2022 MALAWI

In July 2021, Brighter Futures Foundation started its first project in Malawi. Working with local leaders, we began to reconstruct a dilapidated maktab building in the village of Chilipa.

Since this first project, we've launched several other projects in Chillipa and beyond including repairing a masjid and providing Zakat, Sadaqatul Fitr, and Qurbani to local residents. The maktab is expected to be completed in early 2023 and serve the over 600 children in the area.
